



Bachelor of Music in Applied Music (Music Performance)

A Bachelor of Music in Applied Music degree is designed to prepare students for careers in musical performance and equip them for private teaching after graduation. Many students choose to pursue graduate study.

Applied music coursework enables students to become well-rounded musicians and performers. In addition to university core requirements, coursework includes applied lessons, music theory, music history, conducting, and performance pedagogy. Students gain performance experience in wind ensemble, jazz band, orchestra, choir and opera, in addition to small ensemble and various

Admission Requirements

To pursue the Bachelor of Music in Applied Music, students must:

- Apply and be admitted to the University of Houston as a freshman or undergraduate transfer student. International students must have a minimum score of 550 on the paper-based TOEFL or 79 on the internet-based TOEFL.
- Apply separately to the Moores School of Music and complete a successful audition. The music school application is available at www.music.uh.edu. Please note that music school application deadlines may differ from those of the university.

To be fully admitted to the applied music area, students must successfully complete a performance examination (sophomore barrier) and advanced to junior-level applied study. Students must pass the barrier examination in order to complete an applied music degree.
